COLONIES IN AMERICA: We have investigated why different European countries came to North America. The back of this sheet is a bit of review. Reread it before you do the HSC and then hand your parents this sheet and try to explain to them important information about when, where and why the Spanish, Dutch, French and English countries settled where they did. Perhaps look at a map to find out where these places are.
