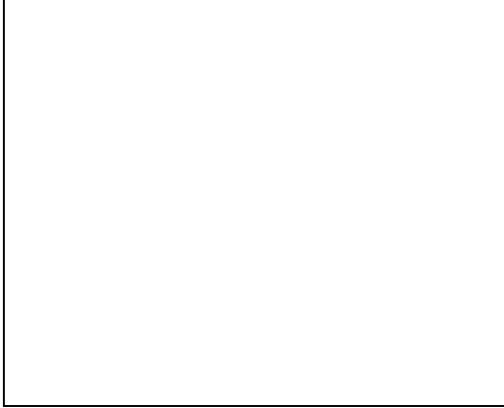

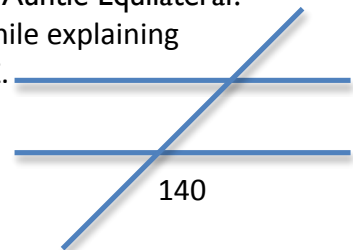
STUDENT DESIGNED HSC

- You may pick from the list on the left or think of your own ideas.

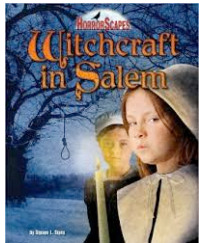
Don't forget the bullets are questions.
